There are now 42 rights holders on the Common of which 6 actively graze stock on the Common. The rights exercised are primarily rights to graze and the active graziers turn out sheep and cows. The Commoners have entered into a Glastir contract to limit grazing on the Common - the Glastir contract has been replaced by an agreement under the Habitat Wales Scheme.

The works form part of a Development of National Significance (DNS) application for a 35MW green energy scheme of Solar PV and Battery Storage.

3-6 weeks

The works consist of laying a 33KV electricity underground cable from the proposed solar site to the substation on Mynydd Maen Common. The laying of the cable will require excavation of a trench (1200mm depth and 600mm width) some 3043m in length along the route outline in the plan appended to the attached Statement of Secondary Consents.

The proposed works will be carried out in sections with excavations being back filled each day. The area disturbed will be reinstated and re-seeded with an appropriate seed mix to reflect the existing grass cover on that area of the Common.

To minimise disturbance to the surface of the common, the cabling route chosen is intended to be the shortest route to the substation allowing for topography and, where possible, will follow the route of existing stone tracks.



1 Introduction

- 1.1 This statement of secondary consent has been prepared by Jeremy D Liley MRICS FAAV on behalf of Cenin Renewables (the applicant) in support as part of a Development of National Significance (DNS) application for a 35 MW green energy scheme of Solar PV and Battery Storage on farmland East of Pantside and within Caerphilly County Borough Council.
- 1.2 Secondary consent under Section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 is for laying of a 33KV electricity underground cable from the proposed Solar site to the Substation on Mynydd Maen Common.
- 1.3 This statement sets out a description of the common, the nature of the proposed works and the legislative and policy consideration for the application for consent, which is dealt with as a secondary consent in the DNS application process.

2 Legislation and Policy Context

- 2.1 By virtue of Section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 consent of Welsh Minsters is needed to construct any restricted works on land registered as Common under the Commons Registration Act 1965. Restricted works are any works that prevent or impede access to or over the land.
- 2.2 As set out in the Welsh Government Common Land Consents Guidance (August 2014) Welsh Government sets out its policy objectives to protect Commons. The Guidance also sets out the consent process and insofar as an application under section 38 is concerned the guidance seeks to achieve that works that take place on Common land are approved only when they maintain or improve the condition of the Common or, in exceptional circumstances, where they confer some wider public benefit and are either temporary in duration or have no lasting impact; and

In determining an Application for consent, Section 39 of the Commons Act 2006 sets out the criteria to which Welsh Government should have regard, as follows:-

A. The persons having rights in relation to or occupying the land (in particular persons exercising rights of Common over it);

- B. The interests of the neighbourhood;
- C. Public interest;
- D. Any other matter considered to be relevant.

Section 39 makes it clear that the public interest includes:-

- A. Nature conservation;
- B. Conservation of the landscape;
- C. Protection of public rights of access to any area of land; and
- D. The protection of archaeological remains and features of historic interest.

3. The Proposed works




Figure 1 – Cable Route over Common

- 3.1 The application under section 38 is for consent to lay an electricity cable 33KW in capacity within a trench (1200mm depth and 600mm width) some 3043m in length over part the Common; a plan of the proposed route is as Figure 1.
- 3.2 The route is from the eastern side of the proposed Solar development site and runs in an Easterly direction to the substation crossing one highway. In some places the trench will be laid within former stone track sections. The proposed sub-station does not form part of this planning application.

4. The Common

- 4.1 The secondary consent is on Mynydd Maen Common (CL 25) ("the Common") and within the administrative area of Caerphilly County Borough Council. Ownership of the Common is between NP20 Limited (part of Llanover Estates Company) the majority of area and Pontypool Park Estates however the work for which consent is being sought is only in respect of that part of the Common owned by NP20 Limited (Llanover Estates company).
- 4.2 The Common is a tract of about 1,570 acres in the Parishes of Abercarn and Panteg.
- 4.3 The Common rights permit the grazing of either Sheep (including lambs) or Cattle or Horses. The ewe and lambs counting as one unit with one horse or one head of Cattle as five units. Some entries have rights to cutting of fern or rush rights on areas on some areas of the Common not owned by NP20 Ltd (Llanover Estates), and those rights will not be impacted by the proposed works.

4.4 The Common is part of a larger common grazed area which incorporates a number of Common land register units, being CL25, CL26 and CL27. Mynydd Maen Amalgamated Commoners Association (the Association") is the recognised graziers Association.

5. Impact of the Proposed Works

- 5.1 The Applicant has designed the proposed works to minimise disruption to the surface of the common and to users of the Common. The route chosen is intended to be the shortest route to the substation allowing for topography and where possible the route follows existing stone tracks to minimise disturbance to the surface of the common.
- 5.2 The proposed works will be carried out in sections, excavations being back filled each day. It is anticipated that the cable trench works will be completed within 3 weeks. The area that is disturbed will be reinstated and re-seeded with an appropriate seed mix to reflect the existing grass cover on that area of the Common.
- 5.3 The proposed route does not cross any public rights of way.
- 5.4 The Common is Public Access Land under the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2002. It is not though envisaged that the temporary works on each section of the trench will have any significant impact on the rights of the public. Once the works have been completed there will be no impact and there will be no restriction on access.
- 5.5 There will be no significant interference with the rights of the commoners to graze as referred to above the sections will be excavated and backfilled daily.
- 5.6 The proposed works do not impact on any archaeological remains and features of historic interest.
- 5.7 The works are necessary for the construction of the proposed Solar PV development. The Applicant considers that the works are in the Public Interest and are temporary in nature with no significant impact on those using the common; in that Applicant's view that constitutes an exceptional reason for the granting of the consent under section 38 of the Commons Act 2006.

6. Consultation

6.1 The Applicant has contacted the Commoners Association to progress and is waiting for their Agent to revert to back. It is the Applicant understanding that the Association does not object the works that are being proposed.

7. Conclusion

7.1 The Applicant considers that the application for Consent under Section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 is appropriate and meets the legislative and policy requirements.

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
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
